



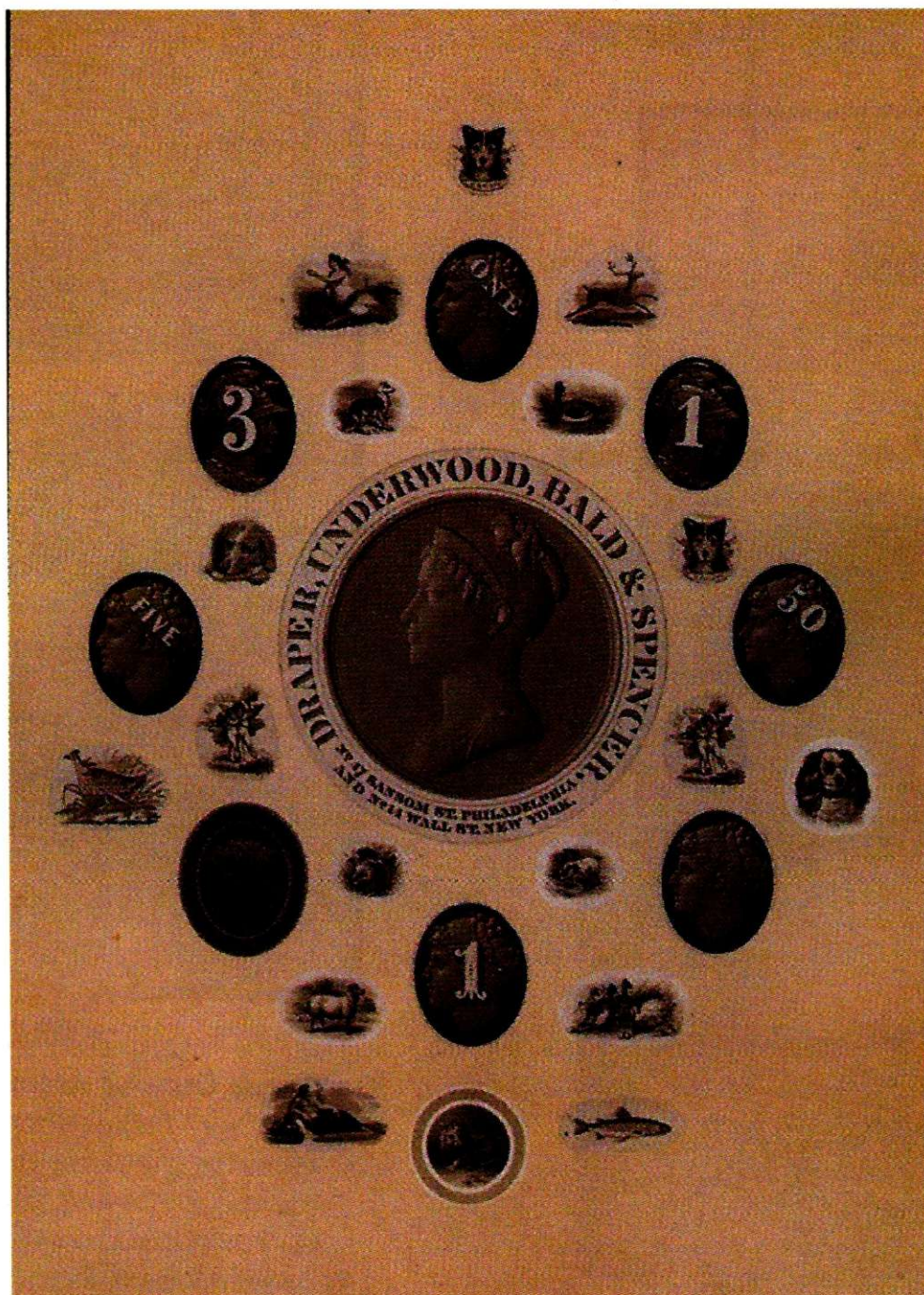

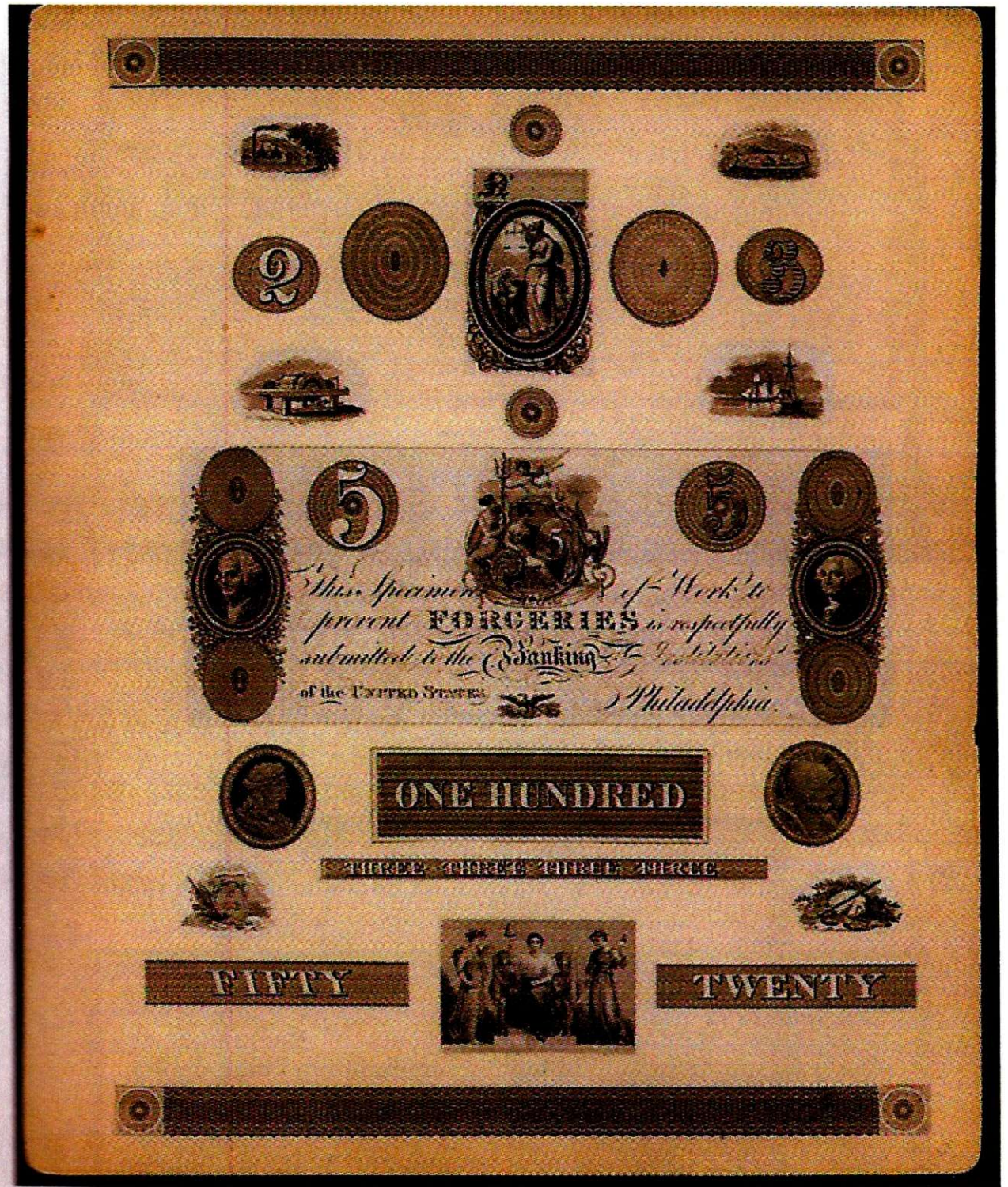

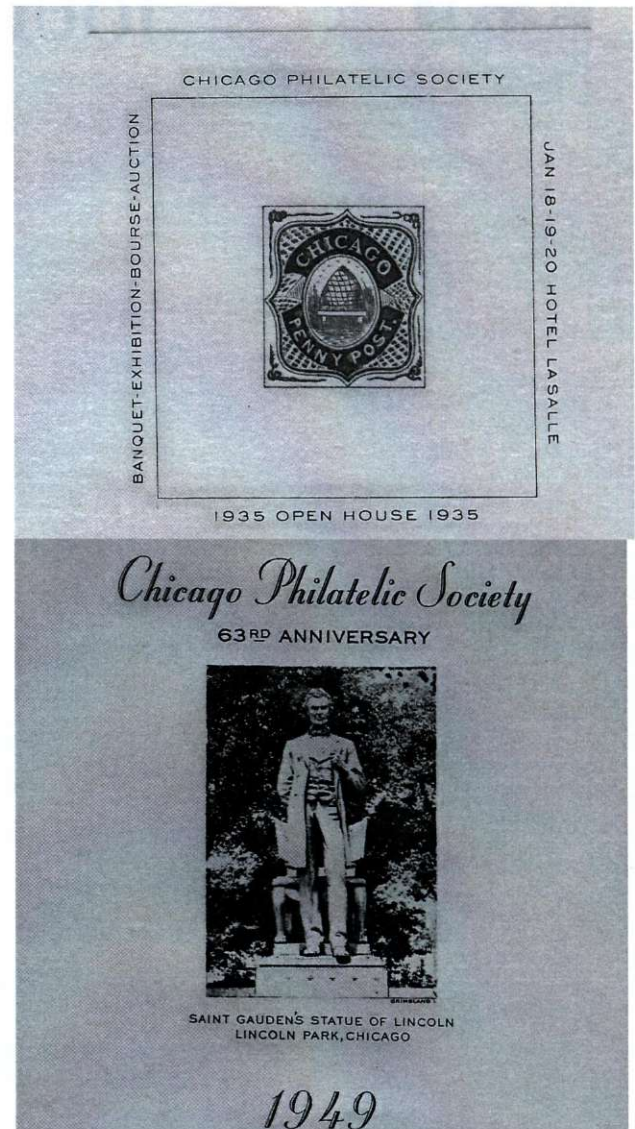

2. Consignors are responsible for adequately describing their lots, including S.C.C.S. numbers and their minimum bids. Lots must be of a minimum \$1 value.

3. Consignors will pay the postage to ship their lots and postage/insurance for return of unsold material. There is NO consignment fee, however, the S.C.C.S. will retain 10% of the selling price as a commission fee. Care shall be taken to protect any material submitted, but the auctioneer and the S.C.C.S. assumes NO liability and the consignor(s) should verify and/or provide their own insurance coverage.

4. Lots will be sold to the highest bidder. In the case of tie bids, the first bid received shall be awarded the lot. Bids below the "minimum" listed are NOT accepted. Bid in \$1.00 increments only, i.e., NOT "cents." There is NO "buyer's premium".

5. Successful bidders will pay the postage, insurance and packaging for their lots. NO lots will be shipped until the notice for same is paid in full. Payment is expected within ten (10) days of notice. Late payment may result in exclusion from future bidding. Checks should be made out to the auctioneer NOT the S.C.C.S.

6. Bids and/or questions may be e-mailed—the quickest way—regular mail, or carrier.

TWO MORE MPC/SC MATCHES

Until recently, I had never seen a Series 701 fractional note and didn't even know they existed. Series 701 was printed but never released and by the time they might have been needed during the 1991 Gulf War, electronic debit cards had made MPC obsolete.

Thanks to a post on a paper money forum, I got a look at a couple images of these. The fractionals are apparently the rarest (and most expensive) of this unissued series and are only found in specimen form.

The 5¢ through 50¢ notes all feature a portrait of Mark Twain on the front and, on the back, the riverboat "Mississippi." Which I recognized immediately. An engraved version of the SS Mississippi is featured on the 1999 souvenir card from the Federal Managers series, FM-7.

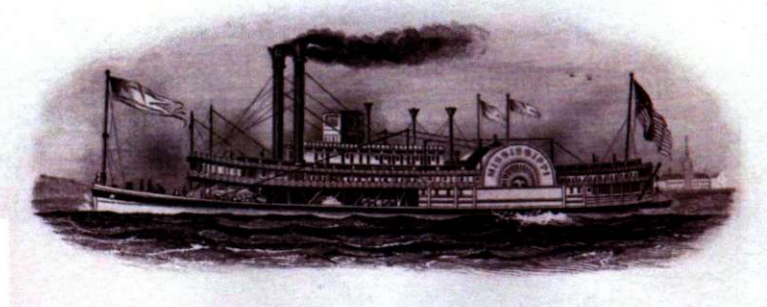
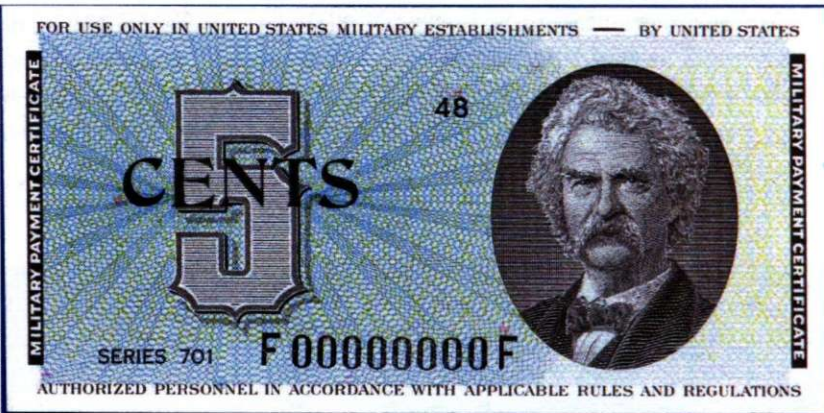
Here's the front and back of the 5 cent note for those who, like me, have never seen one. Along with the matching card.

The second match is not of a vignette or portrait but a notable design element. This match was brought to my attention in the November 2017 issue of *The Numismatist* magazine.

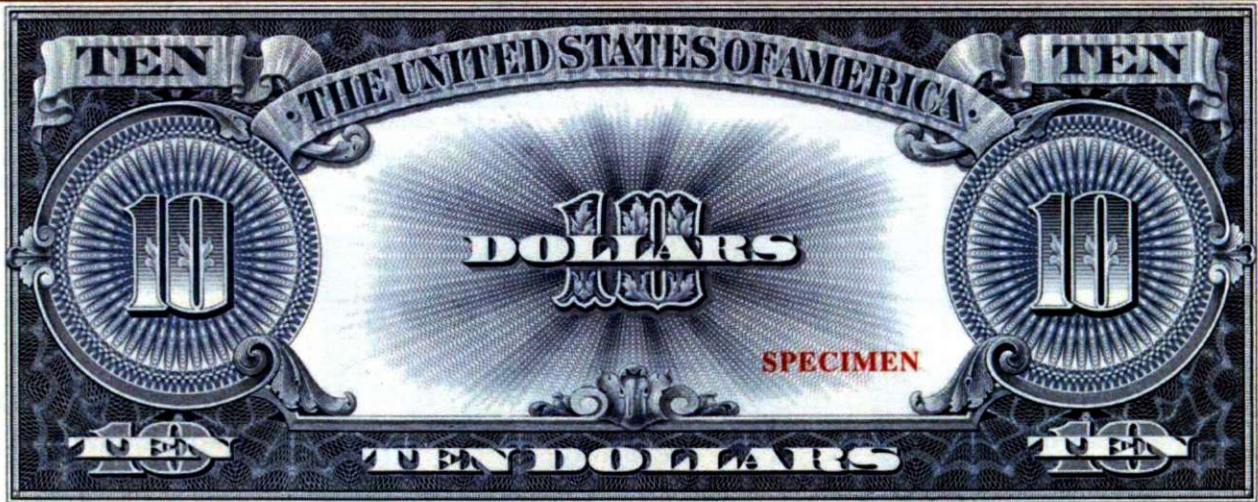

The backs of both the \$10 Series 541 MPC and the \$10 1923 Legal Tender note share a famous circular design element: the so-called "Poker Chip." But the 1923 Poker Chip note is arguably one of the most expensive notes of the last century. Fortunately, the BEP issued B282 at the 2006 Long Beach Show, featuring the back of the legal tender note -- and the souvenir card is a lot more affordable.

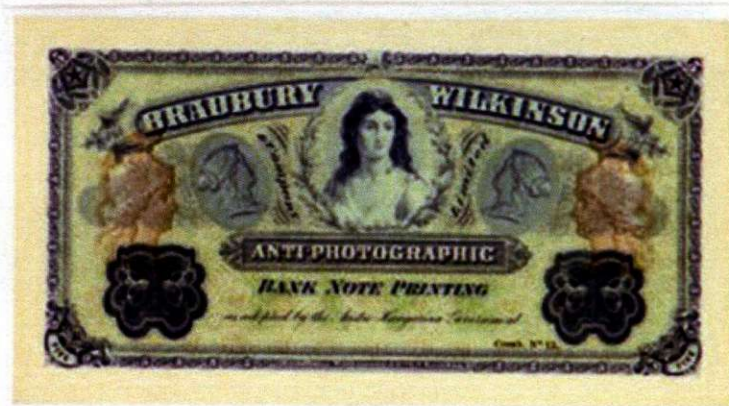

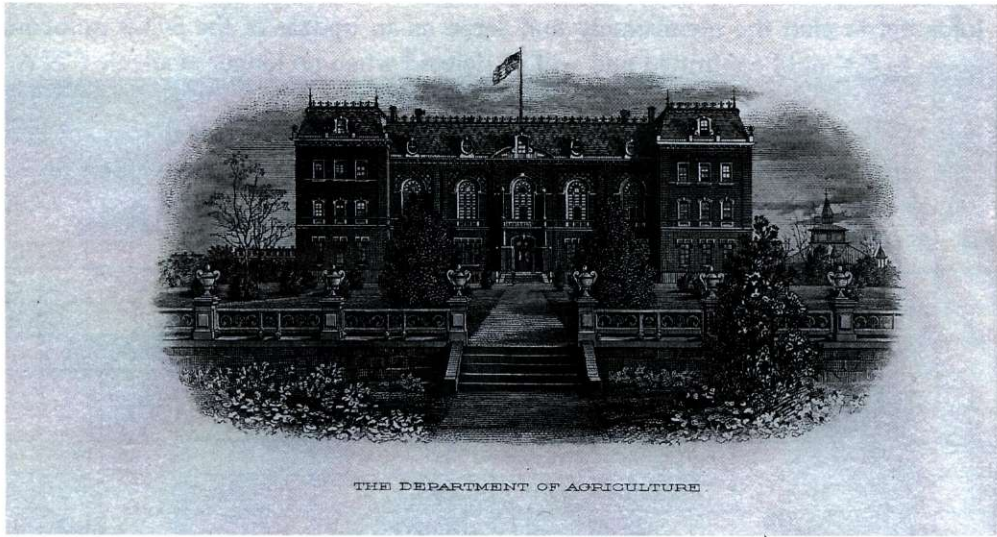
To my knowledgge these cards are no longer available other than on the secondary market, and the engravings on the current cards are new and in most cases from different angles.

These cards are 5.25" x 9", which makes them entirely different than those currently produced. I do not know when these were offered, or when I acquired them.

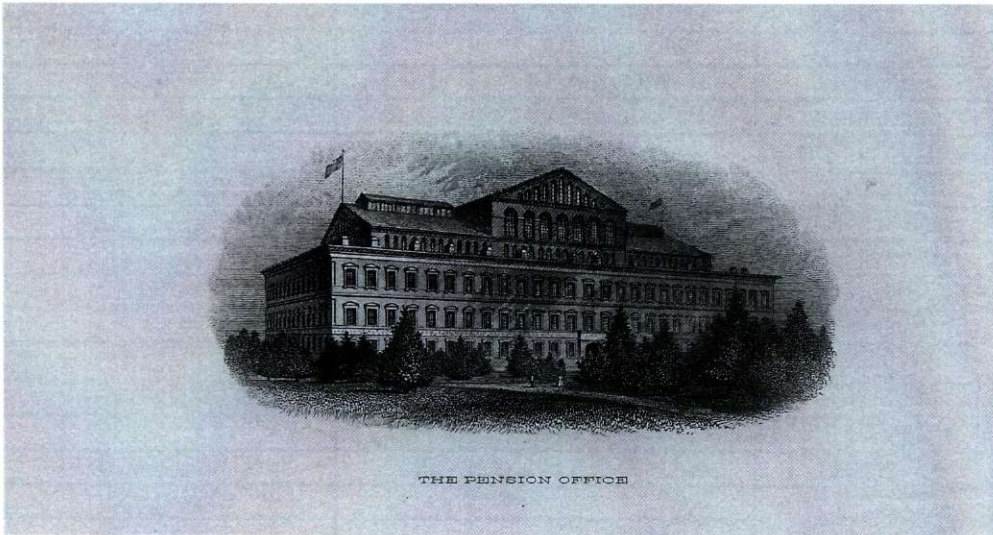
